

TRUCK UTILITY LT MC2 - LAND ROVER SERIES 3 - ALL TYPES
SCREENED IGNITION LEADS

MISCELLANEOUS INSTRUCTION

Introduction

1. Investigation into the high failure rate of screened ignition leads fitted as original equipment to the subject vehicle has shown that the majority had suffered internal short circuits to the mesh wrapping around the leads.
2. Reports of high levels of interference in telecommunication equipment have shown that on failure of the original screened ignition leads unscreened leads have been fitted to the vehicle.

Detail

3. A locally produced screened ignition lead which does not have the physical features which have caused the original problems is available.
4. The lead is called "BATHURST" manufactured by AUSTRALIAN CONTROLS, 511 Keilor Rd, Melbourne. Part Number FB6200. It has been tested and was found to have excellent suppression qualities reducing high frequency interference.

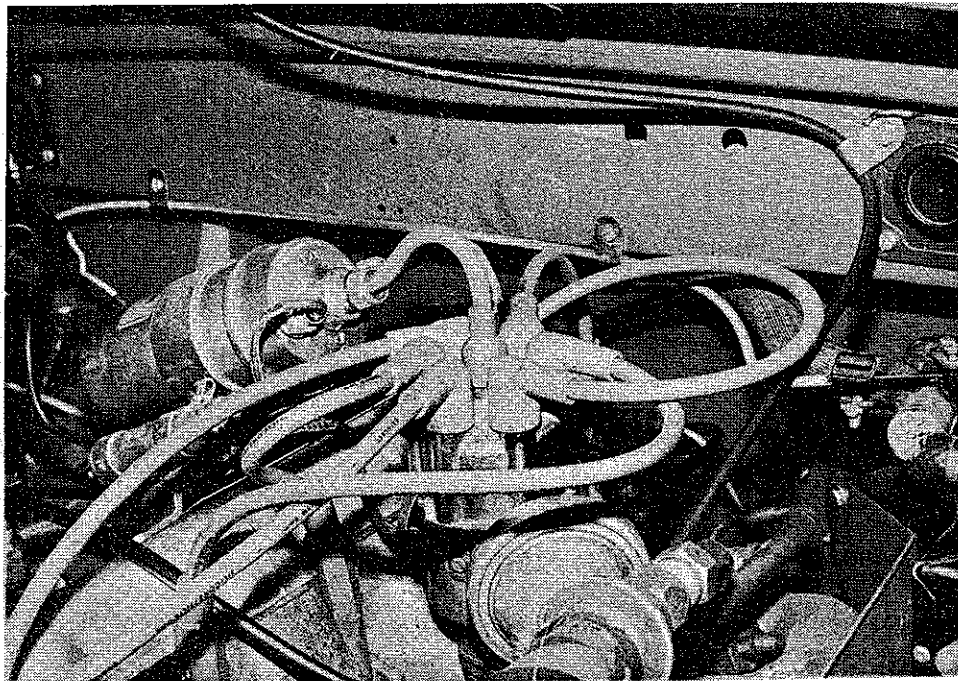


FIG 1 - BATHURST LEADS FITTED TO VEHICLE

6. Spark plugs will require to have a ferrule fitted when installing "BATHURST" leads.
